While my earlier conversation with you speculated as to what might be instore for future consideration, and I can therefore understand why your proposal was prepared in anticipation of the fact that we might need “destructive surveying”, I hope you will not be offended by my need to scale back.

I wonder if you could give me an estimate for the cost of a less extensive evaluation. We would like to limit the inspection to sampling to the main floor rug adhesive, the basement floor residue, some pipe insulation on the furnace, including that in the well pit, and the basement ceiling tile. The thought was put forward that one of your technicians will most likely be able to tell us about the basement ceiling tile by observation.

In the event that we get more ambitious with our plans in the future, we can re-evaluate our needs; but, for the time being, please provide us with an estimate as listed above.

In the meantime, thank you for the time and effort that you have put forward already; and forgive me for my over-reaching in the original request.
