

- B. Zoning Administrator Report:

Zoning Administrator Kucera reported he had sent to the Commissioners a Log of Permits that had been processed to date.

C. Zoning Board of Appeals:

Zoning Administrator reported that oral arguments, if any, would be taken up July 23rd in circuit court in the Kullenberg suit. He has briefs of both parties if Commission members wish to see them. In answer to a question, he reported that construction of the building involved in the court case had been completed and tenants have legally moved in.

9. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Watershed Overlay Work Session

Chairman Wright asked Dave Wynne to speak on the topic. Dave Wynne gave a general overview of the many changes that have taken place inside the Overlay District since 1994 when the Overlay was first approved. He talked about the credentials and expertise held by the many hard-working volunteers who serve on the CLWA's Land Use Committee, and also of the many experts in the field that the Committee had consulted during the past two years the Committee has been working on the project. He talked about cornerstones behind the proposed changes and turned to Zoning Administrator Tom Kucera, who has been working with the Association, to walk the Commissioners through the document that has been prepared for this meeting. Administrator Kucera went through the document's many sections and pages. Commissioner Pasche suggested that storm water management beyond the boundaries of the Overlay District be considered. He also made other suggestions regarding storm water management issues. Zoning Administrator Kucera said the document has been approved by the Crystal Lake Watershed Association and named several other relevant experts in the area who had reviewed the document with a favorable response. He was asked what he and the C LWA wished of the Planning Commission, and he responded that it is their hope that the Planning Commission can soon set a Public Hearing on a final document. Discussion ensued. The Commissioners agreed to hold an informal work session with just two Commissioners present to work on getting the document into a finalized version for possible approval. In addition, Zoning Administrator Kucera said he would be glad to answer by phone any questions or suggestions that individual Commissioners may have.
