However, plans to hold it in July may now change to early August in order to have time to publicize it to township residents. Pasche said we need to divide the issues into two categories: the behavior of renters, and the effects on the common good, including whether or not a growth of such rentals impacts the price and availability of full time housing in the area. Commissioners discussed these matters at length, and have various views on the subject.
