**RESOLUTION SUBMITTING THE QUESTION OF MILLAGE
FOR ASPHALT ROAD IMPROVEMENT, REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE
TO THE TOWNSHIP ELECTORS**

WHEREAS, there are numerous asphalt roads within Crystal Lake Township which are in need of improvement, repair and maintenance;

WHEREAS, in order to provide for such asphalt road improvement, repair and maintenance, the Township is in need of additional funding for a limited period of time; and

WHEREAS, the Township board desires to fund the improvement, repair and maintenance of asphalt roads within the Township through a special millage levy of up to, but no more than, 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of state equalized valuation) for a period not to exceed five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the millage authority proposed by the township board must be approved by the electors of the township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be submitted to the electors of Crystal Lake Township, Benzie County, Michigan, at a November 2019 special election to be held on the 5th day of November, 2019, the following proposition:

Proposal to Renew Road Millage

This proposal reestablishes the 1 mill road millage previously approved by the electors that will expire after the December 2019 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the previously authorized .9861 mills and restores the .0139 mill rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Crystal Lake, Benzie County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of five (5) years, 2020 through 2024, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the improvement, repair and maintenance of asphalt roads in the township, and shall the Township levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$175, 784.00 for the Township in 2020.
