When can I set my fireworks off?

The answer to that question depends on where you live and whether your local government has opted to regulate fireworks.

The State of Michigan says you are allowed to set off legal fireworks the following days after 11 a.m.:

- Dec. 31 until Jan. 1 at 1 a.m.
- Saturday and Sunday before Memorial Day until 11:45 p.m.
- June 29 through July 4 until 11:45 p.m. each day
- July 5, if it falls on a Friday or Saturday, until 11:45 p.m.
- Saturday and Sunday before Labor Day until 11:45 p.m.

~

Besides the days and times listed above, you may not ignite fireworks.

Crystal Lake Township and almost all around the body of water known as Crystal Lake, as well as the City of Frankfort, have restricted fireworks use in their communities via ordinances stating so.

Violations of these local ordinances may result in a fine of \$1,000 per offense.
